## Kyle's Commercial Corner



### October is Cyber Awareness Month

In 2020 alone, 155.8 million individuals were affected by data exposures. To make matters worse, a recent survey found that only half of survey respondents changed their passwords or personal identification numbers following a breach, and 1 in 5 respondents didn't take any action at all.

Data breaches can be costly, not only to individuals, but to businesses as well. According to IBM, the average cost of a stolen customer record is \$148. When you have thousands or even hundreds of records/customers, it can become costly for businesses to recover. According to the National Cyber Security Alliance, 60% of small businesses fail within six months following a data breach, typically due to significant financial and reputation damages. A study by Ponemon Institute found that nearly one-third of respondents stopped doing business with companies following a data breach.

It is important to get out ahead of this growing risk by putting preventative measures in place. Get employees involved in cybersecurity by educating them on how to identify threats. Work with your IT professional to implement cybersecurity measures to prevent breaches. Keep software up to date on all computers, smartphones, and networks to help ensure that malware and virus protection is current. Data should be encrypted and backed up to secure cloud storage. Purchase a cyber insurance policy to help cover the costs of a cyber incident.

### Recipe: Wedding Soup

Directions

- Ingredients**
- 1 Cleared Whole Chicken
  - 2 Cups Diced Carrot
  - 2 Cups Diced Yellow Onion
  - 2 Cups Diced Celery
  - 3 Cloves Minced Garlic
  - 2 Bay Leaves
  - 1-2 Tbsp Chicken Soup Base
  - 1 tsp Black Pepper
  - Mini Meatballs
  - 1-2 Heads Escarole Cleaned and Chopped
  - Acini de pepe pasta

In large soup pot sauté onion, celery, carrot, and garlic in olive oil until softened. Add whole chicken, bay leaves, black pepper, soup base and cover with water. Simmer for several hours or until chicken falls off bones. Carefully remove chicken from pot and de-bone chicken, chop chicken and return to pot. Add mini meatballs and escarole to pot and simmer again until escarole is tender. In separate pot, cook Acini de pepe pasta according to directions, strain and add to individual serving bowls then top with soup.
